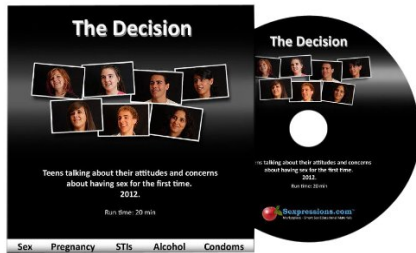

"I Can Wait" is an educational drama for youth about postponing sexual involvement. Youth were involved in all aspects of this project.

"I Can Wait" Story line:

Olivia, a young teen, is having the worst night of her life. She just found out that her boyfriend is seeing someone else. Olivia thinks back over their relationship and conversations with friends, wondering if its because she said "no" to sex. After talking with her older brother, Olivia realizes she's made the right choice for her.

This thought-provoking, educational film highlights the pressures to have sex and the value of waiting. It can be used by individuals, counselors, teachers, youth group leaders, etc.
